Congratulations!

First of all, congratulations on achieving your NLP Practitioner certification. You can feel justifiably proud.

Because your training provider is an Organisational Member of The Professional Guild of NLP, you are now eligible to become an Individual Member of the Guild.

What does membership give you?

Your membership demonstrates your public commitment to belonging to an NLP community which values integrity, skills and quality.

On a practical level, you immediately give yourself a unique package of support and promotion.

- Use of the Professional Guild of NLP seal for your appropriate level of membership.



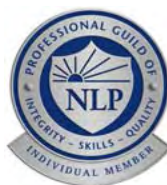
Membership Bands

As you know, NLP practitioners can come by their learning through different routes. Some choose to take their learning to advanced levels, whilst others prefer occasional ‘top-ups’.

In recognition of this diversity, the NLP Register offers different bands of membership, based on numbers of learning hours. Once you have reached the threshold level for the band, your continued registration at this level is dependent on your annual ‘top up’ hours.

<i>Band</i>	<i>Entry</i>	<i>Annual Top Up</i>
Practitioner	120 hours	6 hours
Master Practitioner	240 hours	18 hours
Gold	480 hours	18 hours

The Individual Member ship of the Professional Guild makes you eligible to use the Guild’s seal in your literature and online.



Practitioners may use the designation PGNLP (Practitioner) and Master Practitioners the designation PGNLP (Master Practitioner).



The Gold Band PGNLP (gold) will apply to those who have chosen to specialise in a particular application of NLP, through study, research and application to a level equivalent of a degree.

Continued Development

Your ‘top up’ hours record your learning activities and you can enter these directly to your online profile.

Hours may include any NLP specific development activity, for example attendance at a practice group, conference, and similar activities.

If you want to upgrade your band, then you ask your sponsoring training provider to confirm your information.

On your annual renewal of membership you will be asked to enter the number of hours of development you have undertaken.

Costs

The annual Registration Fees are not subject to VAT.

For renewal, you will be sent out reminders automatically by email before your membership falls due.



Registration Procedure

This is a simple procedure.

- 1 Complete the information on the online Registration Form which can be found at www.professionalguildofnlp.com and click the 'Join' link from any page.
- 2 You can upload a photo directly as JPG or GIF files.
- 3 You may pay online using a credit or debit card, or you can elect to pay by cheque or standing order.

OR

- 1 You may join by completing the form in this booklet
- 2 When complete, send it to the Professional Guild of NLP, with your cheque for £55.
- 3 Please email copy of the details you want included on your entry.

On completion,

- 1 We will contact your Training Provider to endorse your application.
- 2 You will receive an email from us to let you know that your entry has been received. This will give you your password for updating your profile when your account is activated.
- 3 Your relevant jpg logo for your marketing materials.

We seek to complete the process, including the cooperation of your Training Provider within 21 days

Band Level

If you have any doubts, check with your sponsoring training provider, or the Guild

Short Details

This is your sound bite. 10 to 15 words that describe you. This will be used in the search results page of the website.

Details

You have up to 1000 words at your disposal. You may want to consider including:

- Your values and beliefs
- Personal specialisms
- Research and development activities
- Notable achievements
- Client comments

Training History

Here you have the opportunity to demonstrate the breadth and contemporary nature of your NLP learning. You can also record your ongoing development and 'top up' hours.

Integrity

- Adopt the Presuppositions of NLP as the basis of all practice.
- Present self, experience and level of competence honestly.
- Encourage others to learn more about what NLP can offer them, by offering a congruent example and ecological promotion.
- Maintain and respect confidentiality of clients and associates.

Skill

- Recognise the current limitations of own skills and knowledge, and whilst demonstrating flexibility, know when to consult and/or refer on to others as required.
- Maintain and develop own abilities to be in a resourceful state appropriate for the prevailing situations.
- Act ecologically to restore, maintain or generate well-being for self, others and the community.
- Continue NLP learning and development by reviewing, refreshing and updating skills and understanding.

Quality

- Establish well formed outcomes as the starting point of every professional relationship and remember that when working with another, the practitioner's outcome is to assist the other to achieve his or her outcome.
- Maintain records securely and in line with data protection legislation.
- Seek and maintain appropriate supervision and guidance for own area of NLP application.
